HOW TO LEAVE OPPORTUNITY INTERNATIONAL A GIFT IN YOUR WILL

Making a Will is the only way you can be sure that your wishes are understood. It is usually a quick, simple and inexpensive process that ensures that those you care about are well looked after.

If you already have a Will and are thinking about leaving a gift to Opportunity International, you can add a codicil (a short document that is added to your Will).

The best thing to do is to speak to your solicitor who will advise you on how to create or amend an existing Will. They can also provide information about the positive effects of leaving a donation in your Will to the inheritance tax on your estate.
